

LIFT Fact Sheet

What is LIFT?

LIFT vehicles provide origin-to-destination service for people with disabilities who are unable to use BREEZE buses or rail due to their disability and have been certified for eligibility, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Service is available for trips within ¾ mile of fixed bus routes or SPRINTER rail stations.



How much does it cost?

A single ride is \$5.00.



How can I become certified to ride?

Individuals must contact ADARide to become certified to ride LIFT.
